



- UG, THE OLDEST UNIVERSITY IN GHANA, WAS FOUNDED IN 1948

#### "FRENCH-LINKED" GHANA

- FRENCH = MOST-IMPORTANT OF THE FOREIGN LANGUAGES THAT CAN BE ACQUIRED IN GHANA AS SECOND LANGUAGE;
- SECOND LANGUAGE ACQUISITION STATUS [FROM JSS LEVEL ONWARDS]

 ARGUABLY OCCUPIES 03<sup>RD</sup> POSITION ON SCALE OF "SECOND LANGUAGE ACQUISITION" or [SLA] SCALE, AFTER FRENCH

### TEACHING METHODOLOGY FOR [OFFICIAL LANGUAGE / FLA]

- WIDESPREAD USE OF CLASS ROOM SETTING;
- LANGUAGE USE OUTSIDE CLASS ROOM;
- VERY LIMITED USE OF LABORATORY-SUPPORT METHODS

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## SECOND LANGUAGE ACQUISITION [SLA] TEACHING METHODOLOGY

- · ACCESS FROM SECONDARY STAGE;
- WIDESPREAD TEACHING IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS; WITH SUPPORT SYSTEMS [LIMITED USE OF LANGUAGE LABS; LANGUAGE VISITS/EXCHANGES; COMPETITIONS etc
- GHANA'S MEMBERSHIP OF "LA FRANCOPHONY" IN ASSOCIATE MEMBER CAPACITY FROM 2006
- RELATIVELY GOOD USE OF CULTURAL / LANGUAGE INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT eg
- ✓ FRENCH: ALLIANCE FRANCAISE IN MAJOR CITIES; LANGUAGE DEPARTMENTS AT UNIVERSITIES;

SLA METHODOLOGY [cont]

USE OF SPECIALISED INSTITUTIONS eg SCHOOL OF TRANSLATORS; DIVIDENDS FROM OIF MEMBERSHIP [56 MEMBER STATES / GOVTS; 3 AMs; AND 16 OBSERVERS] + SPECIFIC PROJECTS eg BILINGUAL ROAD SIGNS; TRAINING OF GREATER NUMBERS OF FRENCH TEACHERS; ONE YEAR EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES etc

✓ GERMAN: GOETHE INSTITUTE IN MAJOR CITIES; UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENT PROGRAMMES etc

### SLA METHODOLOGY [cont]

- FOR OTHER LANGUAGES
- ✓ BASICALLY SIMILAR ARRANGEMENTS. ACCESS GENERALLY AT TERTIARY LEVEL EXCEPT FOR JAPANESE [WITH ONLY LOCALISED TARGET GROUP MADE UP OF PRIMARY SCHOOL PUPILS IN ACCRA]
- ✓ CHINESE: ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE IN GHANA.
