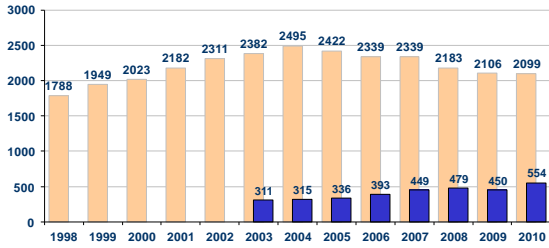

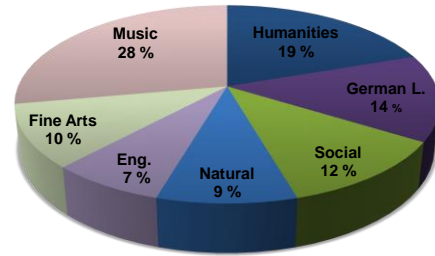

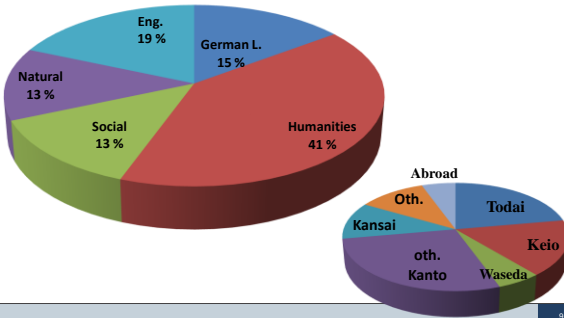

German Students in Japan



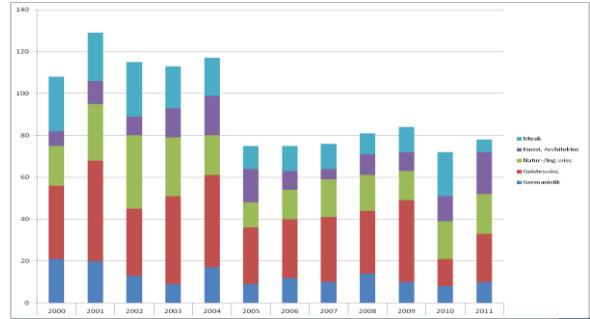
Japanese Students in Germany by Subject (2010)



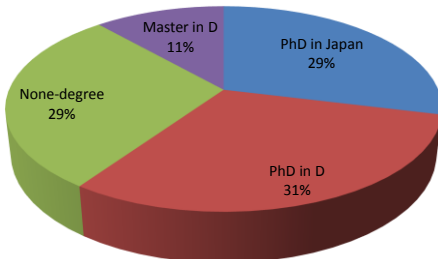
Japanese DAAD Scholars by Subject and Home University, June 2011

Status of German Language Learning in Japan

- > of 3.007.000 university students in Japan, 285.000 learn German, i.e. 9.5%
- > 165 secondary schools offer German language courses
- > 44 departments and chairs of German language and literature at Japanese universities
- > max. 3,500 German language and literature majors (estimate), incl. 2,800 in Tokyo region (2010)

DAAD Scholarship Offers in Japan

- Starter: **Hochschulsommerkurse (HSK) – University Summer Courses**
 - up to three weeks, for students of German language and literature
 - 27 scholarships per year
- Starter: **Intensivsprachkurse (ISK) – Intensive Language Courses**
 - Two months, for students of subjects other than German language and literature
 - 10 scholarships per year
- Main program: **DAAD Graduate Scholarships**
 - 3 years for obtaining PhD in Germany, 2 years for obtaining Master in Germany, one month to one year for research stay in Germany
 - approx. 25 scholarships per year
